

1 MR. BISHOP: No. It was actually on the
2 first agenda, but we're okay.

3 DR. FORT: That's what I thought. We
4 can fix that.

5 MR. BAUSCH: We're back opening the
6 first meeting.

7 MR. BISHOP: Go ahead.

8 MR. BAUSCH: I have been -- disregard --
9 until today's meeting there had been substantial
10 questions that we went through laboriously in
11 dealing with the rights and duties and -- of CRNAs
12 under the O regs that are going to be proposed.

13 Their concern was we cleaned up and clarified
14 the inconsistencies from the E regs to the O regs,
15 which are -- you know, we're now -- we're through
16 the comment period and moving forward. They just
17 want to feel comfortable that the Kentucky Board of
18 Dentistry in the E regs has not in any manner
19 precluded them from taking the actions that we all
20 decided they should be taking today when we voted.

21 And I would like permission to draft an
22 advisory opinion that indicates that the O regs --
23 the E regs be interpreted in the manner consistent
24 with the O regs that have now gone through comment.
25 It's going to be a very short opinion. I have

1 drafted a lengthy one, but you-all made a lot of
2 changes to the regulations that I could not know
3 which way you were going to go. I couldn't have 30
4 different versions, but I put one out. It's
5 inappropriate.

6 So I would like to have permission to do a
7 short opinion letter or advisory opinion allowing me
8 to state that from a legal standpoint that we
9 interpret the E regs consistent with the changes we
10 made to the O regs today. It's about -- it's going
11 to be about that --

12 DR. RICH: I'll make that motion, if it
13 can be motioned in whatever meeting we're in.

14 MR. FRANCIS: I'll second that motion.

15 DR. FORT: All -- any additional
16 discussion?

17 BOARD MEMBERS: (No response.)

18 DR. FORT: All in favor?

19 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.

20 DR. FORT: Any opposed?

21 BOARD MEMBERS: (No response.)

22 DR. FORT: Okay. All right. Thank you.

23 DR. FORT: Now, we're going to adjourn
24 both meetings. Do we have a motion to --

25 DR. RICH: Motion.

18 DR. FORT: Motion to adjourn?

19 MR. FRANCIS: No, we have to deal with
20 that stipulation.

21 MR. BAUSCH: I have an advisory.


22 DR. FORT: Oh, yes. Okay.

23 MR. BAUSCH: I didn't know we were going
24 out and coming back in.

25 DR. FORT: Don't we have to?

1 MR. FRANCIS: I second that.
 2 DR. FORT: All in favor?
 3 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.
 4 DR. FORT: Any opposed?
 5 BOARD MEMBERS: (No response.)
 6 DR. FORT: Thank you. I appreciate
 7 everyone's attendance.
