INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHARITABLE LIMITED DENTAL LICENSURE

Dentists and dental hygienists with an active license in another U.S. state or territory who wish to provide charitable dental services to vulnerable populations in Kentucky may do so without applying for a full license. A charitable limited license is faster, cheaper, and easier to obtain but comes with greater restrictions. See 201 KAR 8:533, 563, and 581 for complete charitable licensing regulations.

Submission Instructions

Mail the license application and fee payment to the address above. Applications should be received at least 30 days prior to the applicant's intended participation in a charitable event to ensure adequate processing time.

The Board will submit a National Practitioner Data Bank query to confirm licensure and review any history of disciplinary action. The applicant will be contacted to resolve any adverse findings.
